

The George Washington Alumni Association Prize

Program Statement

Mission:

The George Washington Alumni Association awards an annual prize to an outstanding graduating student in each school of the University. The award is given to honor future alumni who have shown exceptional commitment to GW and its community.

Eligibility:

- The prize is to be awarded to **one** graduating student, either graduate or undergraduate, chosen by the Dean of each school.
- The recipient must have a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Criteria:

- The recipient must have demonstrated:
 - Curricular and extracurricular accomplishments.
 - Leadership in either campus or community activities.
 - An ability to achieve established goals in these activities.
- A commitment to the University and its community.
- The recipient should show potential for participation in alumni activities and achievement as an alumna/us.

Process:

- The Dean of each school selects the award recipient.

Timetable:

- March Distribute the call for GWAA Prize recipients.
- Mail the memo the Deans: School of Engineering and Applied Science, School of Medicine and Health Science, School of Business, Elliott School of Engineering, Columbian College of Arts and Sciences, Graduate School of Education and Human Development, Law School and School of Public Health and Health Sciences by March 15.
- April Deadline for recipients.
- Schools must notify the Office of Alumni Programs who will receive the prize by April 15.
